

## **PROJECT OVERVIEW**

The Innovation Through Pride and Prevention project (**IP**<sup>2</sup>) is an initiative of The Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH) in collaboration with The **6:52** Project Foundation, Inc.®

ADPH works to identify populations at increased risk for infectious diseases in order to reduce transmission to others and the development of related complications. The 6:52 Project Foundation, Inc.<sup>®</sup> devotes its resources and energy globally to helping individuals and organizations interested in research, education, and/ or the prevention and spread of infectious diseases.

Using a tailored curriculum, **IP**<sup>2</sup> project provides specific training to community\* members who, subsequently, are equipped with the knowledge and ability to translate that training into replication leadership, or 'Community Difference Makers.'
